

## GENERAL: PHOTOGRAPHY / VIDEO & PRIVACY



For all legal purposes WBA premises are private property and recording (photography, video, audio) can be undertaken at the stadium, however there are a number of provisions in order to do so.

- We understand that parents wish to video their own children performing (for a variety of reasons).
- Photographers (professional photographers, spectators, fans, coaches or members of the media) are not permitted unsupervised access to children;
- Any coach, scout or team leader must inform any athlete and parent(s) if they want to video the athlete as a tool to analyse and improve performance; and
- Members of the media and professional photographers must be clearly identifiable for any events held at WBA venues.

However caution should be taken when taking images or video of a child or young person, particularly if they can be identified and you intend to post the images or video on any sort of social media.

## Think before you post

As social media users, we should all be vigilant about what we share. Once posted online any photo or video can be shared, copied and/or manipulated. You may not be able to control how a photo or video is used by others. Before posting a photo or video, think about:

Who might be able to see these images?

When uploading images and video check your privacy settings on the social media services you use as well as on the device to control who sees your images.

Is there anyone else in this photo or video?

Be mindful that some people may not want their image to be published.

Will this image offend anyone?

Are there any identifying details in the image? Do not include personal information such as children's names or team names/numbers.

## Avoid publishing or sharing images and video that:

- are indecent, offensive or demeaning to any person
- harm or injure someone's reputation and/or open them to public ridicule and embarrassment
- contain personal details, for example, names or uniforms that identify teams or location identifiers
- show a child who is clearly upset or distressed.
