

Willetton Basketball Association Modified rules summary for 8s and 10s

10's Rules

In accordance with the By-laws of the Junior Competition the following shall apply for ALL 8's & 10's Grades:

- Raised rings (**Under 10A & 10B Grades**) & Lowered rings (**Under 10C Grades**) to be used with free throws taken from the second peg line (1.8m from the free throw line towards the basket).
- Successful three-point shots shall count as two (2) points.
- 3 Second rule, Cross Court, Travel and Line Violations are called in **FULL** for 10A & B grades.

Following are additional interpretations and applications for the U10C grade.

<u>Rule</u>	<u>After first regrade</u>
3 Seconds	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 3 warnings and then called
Cross Court	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Called – only obvious situations – e.g. dribble or pass clearly into back half – referee to explain<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ball given to opposing team
Travel on start and stop of dribble	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Called – referee to explain• Ball given to opposing team
Line violations on pass-ins	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Referee to talk to the player. Ball given to opposition

8s Rules

In accordance with the By-laws of the Junior Competition the following shall apply for all the 8s Grades:

- No Finals Series will be played.
- No scoreboards shall be used.
- **Lowered rings** shall be used.
- Referees shall determine where free throws shall be taken from.
- A coach is permitted on court briefly during a stoppage in play to position or reassure players, but must leave the court as soon as play is ready to resume. Discretion will be used to allow the flow of the game so long as the coach does not cause an interference to the game.
- Teams are allowed to use Players from any 8s team, including opposing Domestic Clubs, to avoid a forfeit.
- If there is an insufficient number of Players to play a game, the Coach may train their Team.
- Successful three-point shots shall count as two (2) points.
- No timeouts permitted.
- Defence is half court off a dead ball.

Following are additional interpretations and applications for the U8 grade.

<u>Rule</u>	<u>After first regrade</u>
3 Seconds	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Not called
Cross Court	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Not called but communicated
Dribble rule	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This is left to the discretion of the WBA coach
Travel on start and stop of dribble	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Called if no reasonable attempt to stop before stepping or stopping, passing or shooting within a couple of steps (i.e. running with ball) – referee to talk to player. Ball given to opposing team
Line violations on pass-ins	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Referee to talk to the player. Ball given to opposition
