

Gooding Cup Scoring Criteria

• Each Club will start with 1500 points.

How they earn points

• Highest percentage of wins gets 450 points and there is sliding scale of points down to last.

$$1^{st} = 450$$
 $2^{nd} = 400$ $3^{rd} = 350$ $4^{th} = 300$ $5^{th} = 250$ $6^{th} = 200$ $7^{th} = 150$ $8^{th} = 100$

 A club that is nominated by another club for a good act of sportsmanship will receive 150 points.

An example of the above, is a coach reduces his team to 4 players because his opponent only has 4 players and wants to make it a fair game.

• The club that nominates a club for good sportsmanship will also receive 75 points.

How they can lose points

- Any coach, manager or spectator of a club that is ejected from the stadium will result in a loss of 500 points.
- Any player that is ejected from the stadium will result in a loss of 300 points. If they end up at a tribunal, the additional points loss will apply.
- 1st instance of any tribunal will result in a loss of 50 points.
- 2nd instance of any tribunal will result in a loss of 100 points.
- 3rd instance of any tribunal will result in a loss of 150 points.
- Any referee report of bad spectator behavior will result in a 50-point loss.
- Any discretions that occur during the finals of a season, will be deducted from the following season.
